## COMPETITION RULES ALPE ADRIA 3D CUP

### 1. GENERAL

1. The Archery Federations of Austria, Italy<sup>1</sup>, Slovenia and Croatia establish the new 3D archery competition: ALPE ADRIA 3D CUP – AA3DC.
2. Four international AA3DC events, one in each country, will be organized in a calendar year, following WA Rules for 3D Archery.
3. Other WA members are allowed to take part in the events, but cannot be included in the AA3DC results and cannot obtain trophies or medals for the AA3DC.

### 2. CLASSES

1. Junior, senior and master classes are joined according to gender into two classes:
  - Women
  - Men

### 3. DIVISIONS

- Longbow
- Instinctive Bow
- Barebow
- Compound

All characteristics of the bows are as described by WA 3D regulations.

### 4. CATEGORIES

- Longbow women
- Longbow men
- Instinctive Bow women
- Instinctive Bow men
- Barebow women
- Barebow men
- Compound women
- Compound men

### 5. EVENTS

1. The number of 3D animal targets per event is not standardised.
2. The individual finals round is organized at the end of the last tournament of the season and is hosted by a different country every year in a cyclic fashion.
3. The AA3DC results will be prepared for the categories under (4).

### 6. CLASSIFICATION

1. To be included in the final classification of the AA3DC each athlete has to participate in at least three AA3DC events of which the last (final) event is mandatory.
2. Scoring for each AA3DC cup tournament:

1<sup>st</sup> place - 20 points  
2<sup>nd</sup> place - 15 points  
3<sup>rd</sup> place - 10 points  
4<sup>th</sup> place - 7 points  
5<sup>th</sup> place - 6 points  
6<sup>th</sup> place - 5 points

7<sup>th</sup> place - 4 points  
8<sup>th</sup> place - 3 points  
9<sup>th</sup> place - 2 points  
10<sup>th</sup> place - 1 point

Other places do not get points

3. Four competitors of both genders and categories: LB, IB+BB, CO with best total scoring points enter the Finals Round at the last tournament.
4. In case of equal total scoring points at the end of the Cup, the higher rank goes to the competitor with better result in the last (final) tournament.

## 7. INDIVIDUAL FINALS ROUND

1. Finals round is organized on 4+4 targets on the last tournament according to the following rules:

### SEMIFINALS on targets 1-4

LB MEN	pair 1:4 assigned on target 1, pair 2:3 assigned on target 2
LB WOMEN	pair 1:4 assigned on target 3, pair 2:3 assigned on target 4
IB+BB MEN	pair 1:4 assigned on target 1, pair 2:3 assigned on target 2
IB+BB WOMEN	pair 1:4 assigned on target 3, pair 2:3 assigned on target 4
CO MEN	pair 1:4 assigned on target 1, pair 2:3 assigned on target 2
CO WOMEN	pair 1:4 assigned on target 3, pair 2:3 assigned on target 4

The groups will be accompanied by a judge and a scorer, shooting 4 targets in rotation.  
A regrouping follows: losers shooting for the bronze medal, followed by winners shooting for the gold medal.

### FINALS: BRONZE MEDAL MATCH on targets 5-8

LB MEN	assigned on target 5
LB WOMEN	assigned on target 7
IB+BB MEN	assigned on target 5
IB+BB WOMEN	assigned on target 7
CO MEN	assigned on target 5
CO WOMEN	assigned on target 7

The groups will be accompanied by a judge and a scorer, shooting 4 targets in rotation

### GOLD MEDAL MATCH on targets 1-4

LB MEN	assigned on target 1 and 2
LB WOMEN	assigned on target 3 and 4
IB+BB MEN	assigned on target 1 and 2
IB+BB WOMEN	assigned on target 3 and 4
CO MEN	assigned on target 1 and 2
CO WOMEN	assigned on target 3 and 4

The groups will be accompanied by a judge and a scorer, shooting 4 targets in rotation

2. Finals will only take place when there are at least 4 competitors in each category on the last tournament.

## 8. ENTRY FEES

1. Max entry fee is Euro 20,00 when a meal is included. Without a meal max entry fee is Euro 15,00.
2. If the meals are included in the entry fee, this needs to be clearly stated in the invitation.



## 9. MEDALS AND TROPHIES

1. The first 3 ranked athletes in each category will be awarded trophies or medals in each of the 4 events.
2. On the last tournament after the individual Finals Round a trophy for the 1<sup>st</sup> placed athlete in each category for AA3DC is handed out .
3. AA3DC-trophies are provided by the organizer of the last tournament.

## 10. FINAL PROVISIONS

1. AA3DC results must be published on the web site of the Archery Federation organizing the event.
2. The organizer of the final event is responsible for the calculation of the final results.
3. Regulations are valid from the day of confirmation by all 4 nations.
