COMPETITION RULES ALPE ADRIA 3D CUP 2013

1. GENERAL

1. The Archery Federations of Austria, Croatia ,Italy (represented by a Regional Team from Friuli Venezia-Giulia - FVG) and Slovenia establish 2011 the 3D archery competition: ALPE ADRIA 3D CUP – AA3DC.
2. Four international AA3DC events, one in each country, will be organized in a calendar year, following WA Rules for 3D Archery.
3. Other WA members are allowed to take part in the events, but cannot be included in the AA3DC results and cannot obtain trophies or medals for the AA3DC.

2. CLASSES

Junior, senior and master classes are joined according to gender into two classes:

- Women
- Men

3. DIVISIONS

- Longbow
- Instinctive Bow
- Barebow
- Compound

All characteristics of the bows are as described in the WA Rules for 3D Archery .

4. CATEGORIES

- Longbow women
- Longbow men
- Instinctive Bow women
- Instinctive Bow men
- Barebow women
- Barebow men
- Compound women
- Compound men

5. ENTRY FEES

1. Max entry fee is Euro 20,00 when a meal is included. Without a meal max entry fee is Euro 15,00.
2. If the meals are included in the entry fee, this needs to be clearly stated in the invitation.

6. EVENTS

1. The competitions within the Alpe Adria 3DCup are one day events
2. The number of 3D animal targets per event is not standardised, but a minimum of 28 is required.
3. The individual finals round is organized at the end of the last yearly tournament and is hosted by a different country each year in a cyclic fashion.



7. CLASSIFICATION

1. To be included in the final classification of the AA3DC each athlete has to participate in at least three AA3DC events of which the last (final) event is mandatory.
2. Scoring for each AA3DC cup Tournament
 - 1st place - 20 points
 - 2nd place - 15 points
 - 3rd place - 10 points
 - 4th place - 7 points
 - 5th place - 6 points
 - 6th place - 5 points
 - 7th place - 4 points
 - 8th place - 3 points
 - 9th place - 2 points
 - 10th place - 1 pointOther places do not get points
3. Four competitors of both genders and categories: LB, IB, BB and CO with best total scoring points enter the Finals Round at the last tournament.
4. In case of equal total scoring points at the end of the Cup, the higher rank goes to the competitor with better result in the last (final) tournament.
5. Finals will only take place when there are at least 4 competitors in a category

8. MEDALS AND TROPHIES

1. For each Cup-event:
The first 3 ranked athletes in each category will be awarded trophies or medals.
2. Cup 2013:
On the last tournament after the individual Finals Rounds a trophy for the 1st placed athlete in each category is handed out which is to be provided by the organizer of the last tournament .

9. INDIVIDUAL FINALS ROUND

1. Semifinals and Finals Round are organized on 4 targets as per the following targetassignment:

SEMIFINALS (per Division)

LB MEN	pair 1:4 assigned on target 1, pair 2:3 assigned on target 2
LB WOMEN	pair 1:4 assigned on target 3, pair 2:3 assigned on target 4
IB MEN	pair 1:4 assigned on target 1, pair 2:3 assigned on target 2
IB WOMEN	pair 1:4 assigned on target 3, pair 2:3 assigned on target 4
BB MEN	pair 1:4 assigned on target 1, pair 2:3 assigned on target 2
BB WOMEN	pair 1:4 assigned on target 3, pair 2:3 assigned on target 4
CO MEN	pair 1:4 assigned on target 1, pair 2:3 assigned on target 2
CO WOMEN	pair 1:4 assigned on target 3, pair 2:3 assigned on target 4

The groups will be accompanied by a judge and a scorer, shooting 4 targets in rotation.



2. Since there is only a AA3DC- trophy for the Total Cup (9.2) for the first place/Division, to win the yearly Trophy the winners of the Semifinals per Division will shoot a CUP WINNER MATCH as follows

LB MEN	assigned on target 1
LB WOMEN	assigned on target 2
IB MEN	assigned on target 1
IB WOMEN	assigned on target 2
BB MEN	assigned on target 1
BB WOMEN	assigned on target 2
CO MEN	assigned on target 1
CO WOMEN	assigned on target 2

The pair will be accompanied by a judge and a scorer, shooting 4 targets in rotation

10. RESULTS

1. The AA3DC results will be prepared for the categories under (4).
2. AA3DC results must be published on the web site of the Archery Federations organizing the yearly events.
3. The Federation hosting the final event is responsible for preparing and publishing the intermediate and final yearly results (The organisers of the other AA3DC will send the results of their competition to that Federation soonest after the event has been held).
