



## COMPETITION RULES ALPE ADRIA FIELD CUP 2013

### 1. GENERAL

1. The Archery Federations of Austria, Croatia, Italy (represented by a Regional Team from Friuli Venezia-Giulia) and Slovenia establish 2010 the field archery competition: ALPE ADRIA FIELD CUP – AAFC.
2. Four international AAFC events, one in each country, will be organized in a calendar year, following WA Rules for Field Archery.
3. Other WA members are allowed to take part in the events, but cannot be included in the AAFC results, and cannot obtain trophies or medals for the AAFC.

### 2. CLASSES

Junior, senior and master classes are joined according to gender into two classes:

- Women
- Men

### 3. DIVISIONS

- Barebow
- Recurve
- Compound

All characteristics of the bows are as described in the WA Rules for Field Archery

### 4. CATEGORIES

- Barebow women
- Barebow men
- Recurve women
- Recurve men
- Compound women
- Compound men

### 5. ENTRY FEES

1. Max. individual entry fee for
  - a) 1 day competition: Euro 20,00 including 1 meal - Euro 15,00 without a meal
  - b) 2 days competition Euro 35,00 including 2 meals – Euro 25,00 without a mealIf the meals are included in the entry fee, this needs to be clearly stated in the invitation.
2. Max. entry fee for teams:  
Euro 6,00 per team (Euro 2,00 per member).

### 6. INDIVIDUAL EVENT

1. The event will run over 1 or 2 days.  
A competition-day will consist of 12 targets unknown and 12 targets known distances.



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## 7. TEAM EVENT

1. AAFC events will include a Team Round, to be shot on the first competition day after the individual event
2. The Team Round will be organised as per WA Rules 2012, Book 2, Chapter 4, Article 4.5.3.4.5.
3. Each AAFC-Archery Federation can take part in the AAFC Team Round with one men and one women team.
4. For team ranking purposes, the best scores in each category are taken.
5. The team will be made up by one archer of each division.
6. Mixing of genders in teams is not allowed.
7. The BB can replace RE or CO, RE can replace CO, but the arrows must be shot from the distance designated for the bow it replaces.
8. Athletes for each Team Round will be nominated by the team captain.

## 8. INDIVIDUAL CLASSIFICATION

1. In order to be included in the final classification of the AAFC each athlete has to participate in at least three AAFC events.
2. Individual scoring for each AAFC tournament:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> place - 20 points
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> place - 15 points
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> place - 10 points
  - 4<sup>th</sup> place - 7 points
  - 5<sup>th</sup> place - 6 points
  - 6<sup>th</sup> place - 5 points
  - 7<sup>th</sup> place - 4 points
  - 8<sup>th</sup> place - 3 points
  - 9<sup>th</sup> place - 2 points
  - 10<sup>th</sup> place - 1 pointOther places do not get points
3. For the final classification only the best three results are considered.

## 9. TEAMS CLASSIFICATION

Team scoring for each AAFC team event:

- 1<sup>st</sup> place - 20 points
- 2<sup>nd</sup> place - 15 points
- 3<sup>rd</sup> place - 10 points

## 10. MEDALS AND TROPHIES

- 1) Individual:
  - a) For each Cup event :  
The first 3 ranked athletes in each category will be awarded trophies or medals
  - b) Cup 2013:
    - I) On the last tournament a trophy for the 1<sup>st</sup> placed athlete in each category for the AAFC is handed out, which is to be provided by the organizer of the last tournament.
    - II) In case of equal total scoring points after 4 events there will be a shoot off for the first place of the Cup 2013.
- 2) Teams Cup 2013:
  - a) At the 4th event after the Team Round, the first 3 ranked teams of the Cup 2013 will be awarded 3 trophies/team to be provided by the organisers of the last tournament .
  - b) In case of equal scoring in the positions 1 – 3, there will be a shoot off. (Teams of the last event doing the s.o.)



## 11. RESULTS

1. The AAFC results will be prepared for categories under (4).
2. AAFC results must be published on the web site of the Archery Federation organizing the yearly events.
3. The Federation hosting the final event is responsible for preparing and publishing the intermediate and final yearly results (The organisers of the other AAFC will send the results of their competition to that Federation soonest after the event has been held)
