



COMPETITION RULES ALPE ADRIA FIELD CUP 2014

1. GENERAL

1. The Archery Federations of Austria, Croatia, Italy (represented by a Regional Team from Friuli Venezia-Giulia) and Slovenia established 2010 the field archery Cup: ALPE ADRIA FIELD CUP – AAFC.
2. As per 2014 the Archery Federation of Hungary will officially take part also.
3. Four (4) international AAFC events within the AAFC, will be organized in a calendar year, following WA Rules for Field Archery.
4. The 4 event-Federations will rotate each year and one of the 5 AAFC Federations will refrain from organising an AAFC event in that year. For 2014 that will be the Regional Team from Friuli Venezia-Giulia.
5. The organisers will register the event in the WA-Calendar.
6. Other WA members are allowed to take part in the events, but cannot be included in the AAFC results, and cannot obtain trophies or medals for the AAFC.

2. CLASSES FOR THE ALPE ADRIA CUP FIELD CLASSIFICATION

Junior, senior and master classes are joined according to gender into one age class and a resultlist will be issued to this effect:

- Women
- Men

3. DIVISIONS

- Barebow
- Recurve
- Compound

All characteristics of the bows are as described in the WA Rules for Field Archery

4. CATEGORIES

- Barebow women
- Barebow men
- Recurve women
- Recurve men
- Compound women
- Compound men

5. ENTRY FEES

Entry fees for the individual event as well as for the team-event will be laid down by the organiser.

6. INDIVIDUAL EVENT

1. The event will run over 1 or 2 days.
A competition can consist of either
12 targets unknown and 12 targets known distances per day, for which two competition fields are required
or
per day separate 24 known and 24 unknown distances.



7. TEAM EVENT

1. AAFC events will include a Team Round, to be shot on the first competition day after the individual event
2. The Team Round will be organised as per WA Rules 2014 04 01 , Book 2, Chapter 4, Article 4.5.3.4.5.
3. Each AAFC-Archery Federation can take part in the AAFC Team Round with one men and one women team.
4. For team ranking purposes, the best scores of each AAFC-Federation in each category are taken.
5. The team will be made up by one archer of each division.
6. Mixing of genders in teams is not allowed.
7. The BB can replace RE or CO, RE can replace CO, but the arrows must be shot from the distance designated for the bow it replaces.
3. Athletes for each Team Round will be nominated by the team captain.

8. INDIVIDUAL CLASSIFICATION

1. In order to be included in the final classification of the AAFC each athlete has to participate in at least three AAFC events.
2. For the final classification only the best three results are considered.
3. Individual scoring for each AAFC tournament:

1st place - 20 points
2nd place - 15 points
3rd place - 10 points
4th place - 7 points
5th place - 6 points
6th place - 5 points
7th place - 4 points
8th place - 3 points
9th place - 2 points
10th place - 1 point
as from the 11th place no points are given

9. TEAM CLASSIFICATION

Team scoring for each AAFC team event:

1st place - 20 points
2nd place - 15 points
3rd place - 10 points

10. MEDALS AND TROPHIES

- 1) Individual:
 - a) For each Cup event :
The first 3 ranked athletes in each category will be awarded trophies or medals by the event organisers
 - b) Cup 2014:
 - I) On the last tournament a trophy for the 1st placed athlete in each category for the AAFC is handed out, which is to be provided by the organiser of the last tournament.
 - II) In case of equal total scoring points after 4 events there will be a shoot off for the first place of the Cup 2014.
- 2) Team Cup 2014:
 - a) At the 4th event after the Team Round, the first 3 ranked teams of the Cup 2014 will be awarded 3 trophies/team to be provided by the organisers of the last tournament.
 - b) In case of equal scoring in the positions 1 – 3, there will be a shoot off. (Teams of the last event doing the s.o.)



11. RESULTS

1. The AAFC results will be prepared for categories under (4).
2. AAFC results must be published on the web site of the Archery Federation organising the yearly events.
3. Requests for corrections in the result list must be sent to the organisers within 10 days after the event.
1. The Federation hosting the final event is responsible for preparing and publishing the intermediate and final yearly results.
Therefore the organisers of the other AAFC must send the results of their competition to that Federation soonest after the event has been held.
