FAQ - Set System

Book 1, Chapter 3

Question:

Which rounds are being shot in 2010 and after following the 2009 Congress decisions?

Response:

From 1 April 2010 we will use a set system for all eliminations and finals for recurve. All World Cup events, Grand Prix, European Championships, University Championships and other major events will use 70m Qualification Round, or 4-distances FITA Round for World Cups and World Archery Championships in the year of the World Archery Championship, followed by match play using sets at 70m for recurve.

For the 2013 Archery World Cup stages, World Archery will use the 50m finals for compound bows with cumulative scoring for individuals, team and mixed team events.

The 2013 World Cup Final in Paris will have 50m cumulative scoring for compound and set system at 70m for recurve.
